

# 7A Partnership Community Points

Each RA will be responsible for earning Community Points throughout the semester. CPs are given for various initiatives the RA does for the floor, including programming, passive engagement, conversations, and conflict resolution. This means that:

- RAs can customize their interaction with the floor to do what serves residents best
- There is not a specific number of floor programs required, though we expect programming to happen
- Community Points planning and budgeting will go hand in hand

## HOW IT WORKS

1. RA holds a program and submits program planner evaluation
2. The Residence Hall Assistant Director will assess how many points the program is worth
3. The points the program earned will be provided via ThinkTank (program evaluation system)
4. Non-programming Community Points will be discussed in 1:1 meetings

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**YOU ARE REQUIRED TO OBTAIN 150 POINTS IN THE SPRING  
RECEIVING 75 OF THEM BY 3/14**

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## PROPER POINTS OBTAINMENT

- Plan ahead of time! Community Point initiatives must be outlined during 1:1 meetings. This means DETAILS should be planned about a month in advance.
- RAs must advertise to their entire floor about programs via weekly email and one additional method
- RAs must complete online program planner and evaluation form in ThinkTank
  - Program planner completed **5 DAYS BEFORE** the program takes place
  - Receipts submitted and evaluation completed **by 9am the Monday following your program.**
- If the program requires funding, funding guidelines must be followed
- Budget updates will be sent in the Happy Monday e-mail ☺
- Add-on points can only be obtained on top of other points received
- Many Community Points will be reported at your 1:1 – it's the honor system
- Unfortunately, no points will be received for programs with no residents in attendance



The **Home Sweet Home badge** will be awarded to anyone that gets 200 or more Community Points!
