AWARD DESCRIPTIONS:

Harry Canon Outstanding Professional

Outstanding Men's Program

This award is given to a program or intervention at an institution of higher education that has had a positive impact on men's development.

SCM Outstanding Research Award

This award is given to an individual who has completed journal quality research regarding men's development.
