



2nd Annual Women Writing for Publication Workshop “Finding Your Voice in Scholarly Writing for Publication”

In order to strengthen the visibility of women scholars, the Standing Committee for Women (SCW) initiated a Women Writing for Publication program in 2013. Each year, on the day prior to the annual ACPA Convention, a workshop is hosted by the SCW Senior and Emerging Scholars-in-Residence. This year the topic of the workshop is designed to assist those who may struggle with finding or keeping their voice while writing for scholarly publications. This could include journals, magazines, newsletters, book chapters, blogs, etc.

The SCW is soliciting applications from women seeking assistance with non-thesis/dissertation scholarly writing projects. Women must be members of ACPA and be able to attend a one-day workshop on Saturday, March 29, 2014 from 9:00am-5:00pm at the Marriott Downtown in Indianapolis, IN.*

The goal of this workshop is to help women find their voice thru reflection, ultimately answering the question, “Who are you as a scholar?” This will be accomplished through:

- Knowledge dissemination regarding publications, the role of voice, and potential obstacles
- Sharing of narratives and personal experiences by a small group of published women
- Guided reflection exercises, both group and individual, with on-site support and discussion
